



## Policy SEC-02 GOLF CARTS

### 1.0 REFERENCE(S)

- Board Motion 2005-029

### 2.0 PURPOSE

ISHOA recognizes that the safety of all homeowners and security of their property can be compromised when under-aged or unlicensed persons are driving golf carts on ISHOA streets, and if licensed person driving golf carts do not follow Washington State motor vehicle laws.

### 3.0 POLICY

No person may operate a golf cart on ISHOA roads unless that person has a valid driver's license and obeys the motor vehicle laws of Washington State.

- Obey posted speed limits
- Drive on the correct side of the road
- Come to a full stop at intersections with posted signage and when crossing road between golf course holes
  - Troon (from Proshop to hole #1)
  - Prestwick (from hole #4 to hole #5)
  - Prestwick (from hole #6 to hole #7)
  - Troon (from hole #8 to hole #9)
  - Turnberry (from hole #11 to hole #12)
  - Prestwick (from hole #13 to hole #14)
  - Prestwick (from hole #16 to hole #17)
  - Prestwick (from Proshop parking to driving range)
- Use light or hand signals when turning
- Maintain cart in safe operational condition

### 4.0 RESPONSIBILITY FOR POLICY

The ISHOA Board or its delegate is responsible for enforcing, maintaining and keeping this policy current and to obtain Board approval of changes, as necessary.
